I woke up today with a call from one of the girls who God has trusted me to be available to. I know her from the drug and alcohol recovery circuit, where I had chaplained in the past.

She is a vile alcoholic, and in and out of the sex industry for years. She had been being sex trafficked. The man who was trafficking her, did worse than mention-able to her.

She called me in a panic. She was transported to her moms house, where she asked me to sit with her. She was scared and suicidal. I went and we talked. She calmed down.

I called the Justice Coalition (our anti sex trafficking outreach and Christian ministry here in the Valley). They told me to have her make a police report and they emailed me a list of safe homes and shelters in the Fresno area.

I took her to the police station to file a report and she was transported to the emergency room. She was admitted into the emergency room and registered as 51/50.

I know this girls mother from church and she is a youth counselor at Turning Point. She was also a volunteer at the same expulsion school where I volunteered at, we share friends still mutually. Please keep my friend and her mother/ family in prayer.

Pray for this woman's life and surrender to Jesus Christ, whom she seeks just by the fact that she reaches out to me. That's what I'm all about, and she knows that."
